THE VISION:

Guazabara Insights, LLC is a health and educational services provider whose mission is to raise social consciousness and uplift our communities. We enact our mission through the dissemination of cultural and social consciousness education. For the past couple of years, we have been working diligently in implementing our cultural educational modules in communities of need, while addressing the social issues that affect our communities through organizing and action.

This year our UPLIFT! Youth Education Program, which worked with youth in need is now an approved provider of children's behavioral health services through the State of New Jersey. We now provide Intensive In-Community Therapy (IIC) and Behavioral Assistance (BA) Services; which provides therapeutic and mentoring services to youth and their families referred by one of the system partners of New Jersey's Children System of Care (CSOC).

For the past three years, we have been executing programming inside correctional facilities, as well as assist post-incarcerated with reintegration into their respective communities

We employ such services while also educating our communities on the conditions that lead to destabilization in our homes, so as to assist in the mending of our families through community action and involvement. Our educators/therapists receive training in our curriculums, while also receiving continuing education to further their career prospects.

We are seeking individuals who are not also educated in their field, but also express concern for the ills that affect our community at large, and seek to remedy such ills through community action and involvement: through the *wrap-around* approach.

While we service any family in need of assistance, our focus is with our disadvantaged populations who are leading to or are already involved with the criminal justice system of New Jersey. Our services and approach have proven time and time again, that the implementation of self-knowledge curriculums, community involvement, while also receiving licensed therapy go much further in creating a sense of stability and independence for our families, than most traditional approaches. The needs in our communities require approaches that are creative and through the use of cultural education to cross barriers that most traditional approaches cannot cross.

Student Intern Responsibilities
